

Beaver Dam Colony June 17, 2024











2024 Season

Challenging to observe herons in live trees Lowest number of nests (-52%) Phenology was "normal" after slow start High reproductive success (100%) Highest number of chicks per nest (3.4)

Less disturbance in new site

More vulnerable to road impacts (fall projects)

River recreation – morning observations

Dead branches on trees

2025 Season

Continue monitoring


